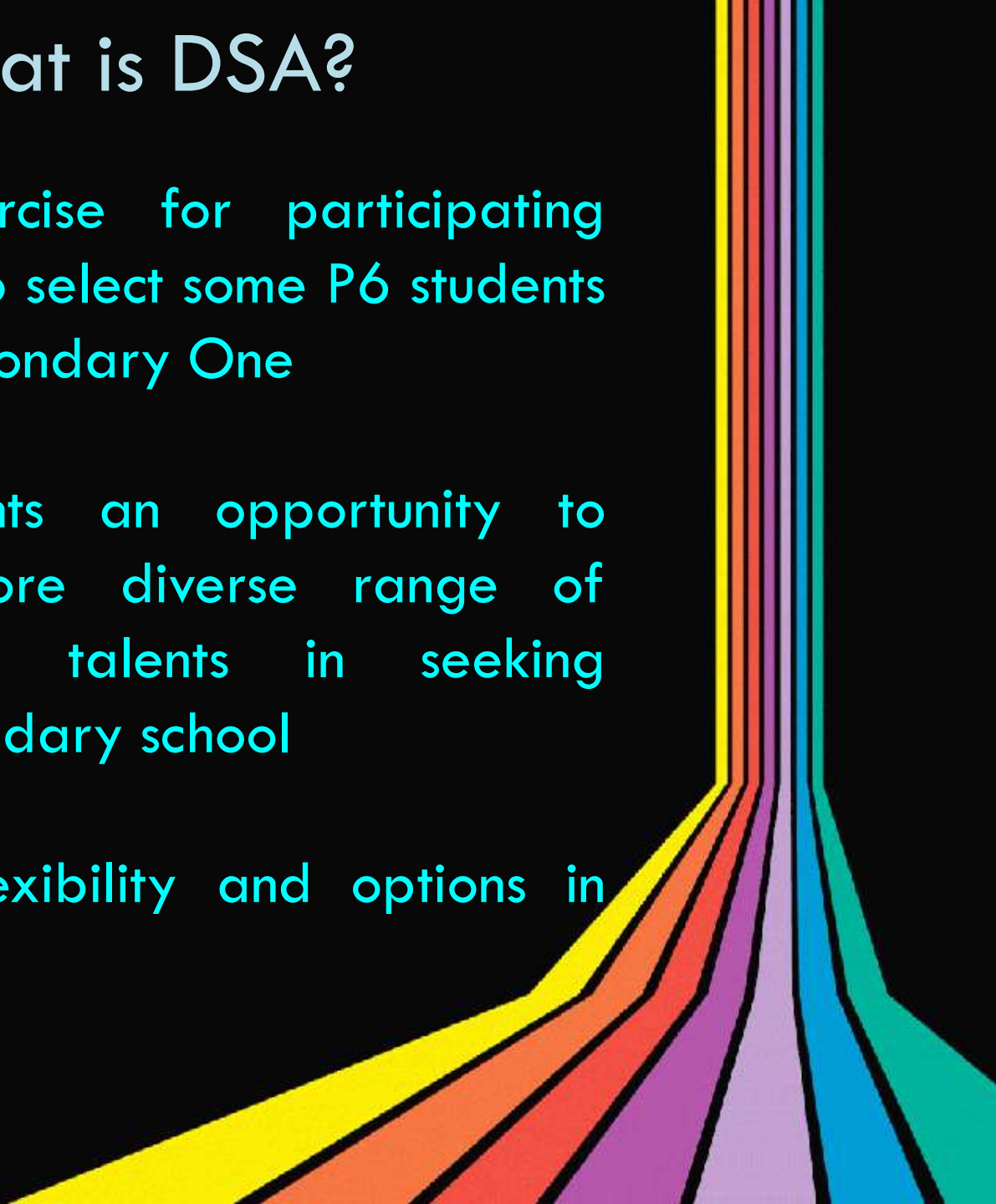

Direct School Admission (DSA)

What is DSA?

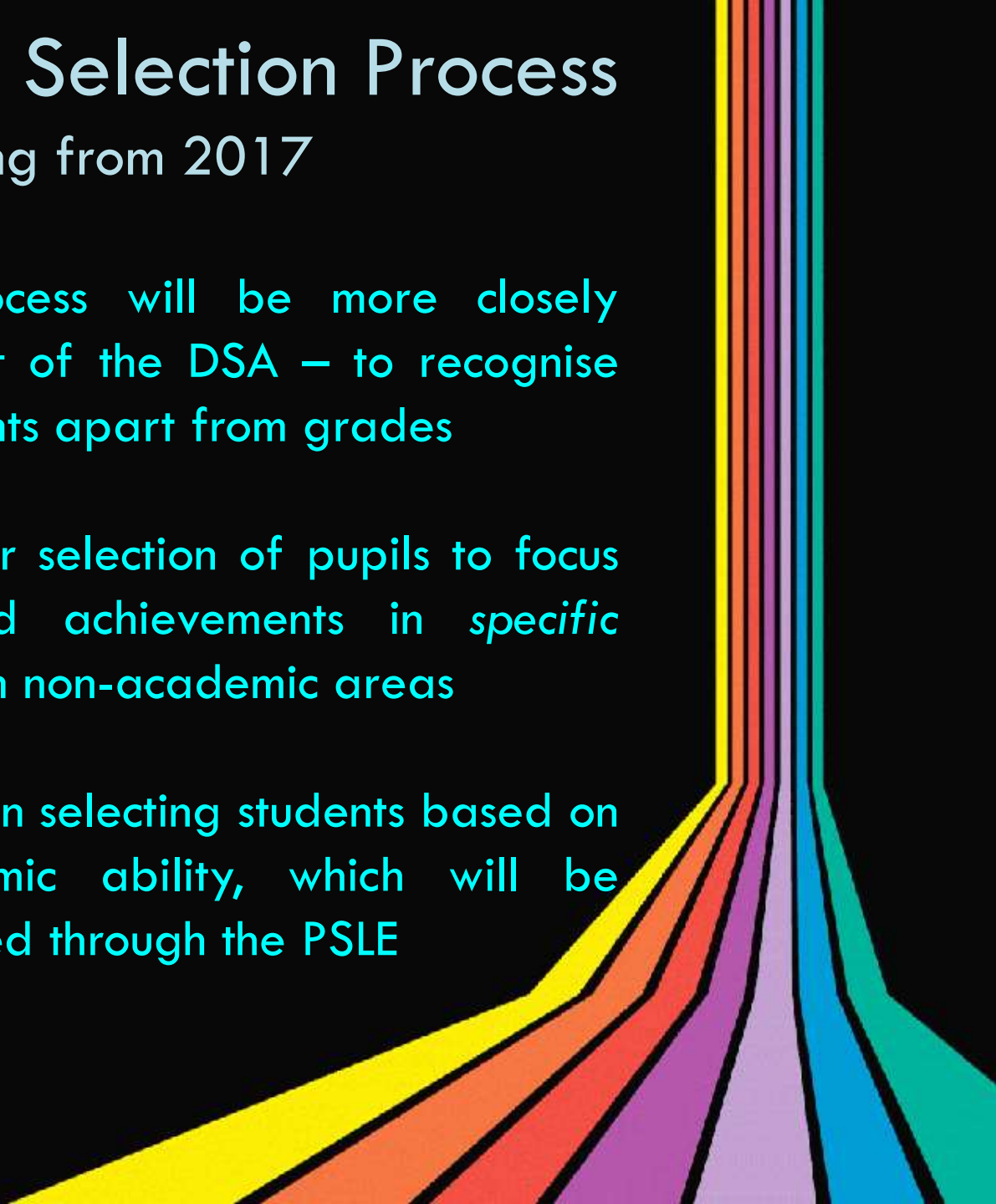
- An Admission Exercise for participating secondary schools to select some P6 students for admission to Secondary One
- To provide students an opportunity to demonstrate a more diverse range of achievements and talents in seeking admission to a secondary school
- To create more flexibility and options in school admission



Refined DSA Selection Process

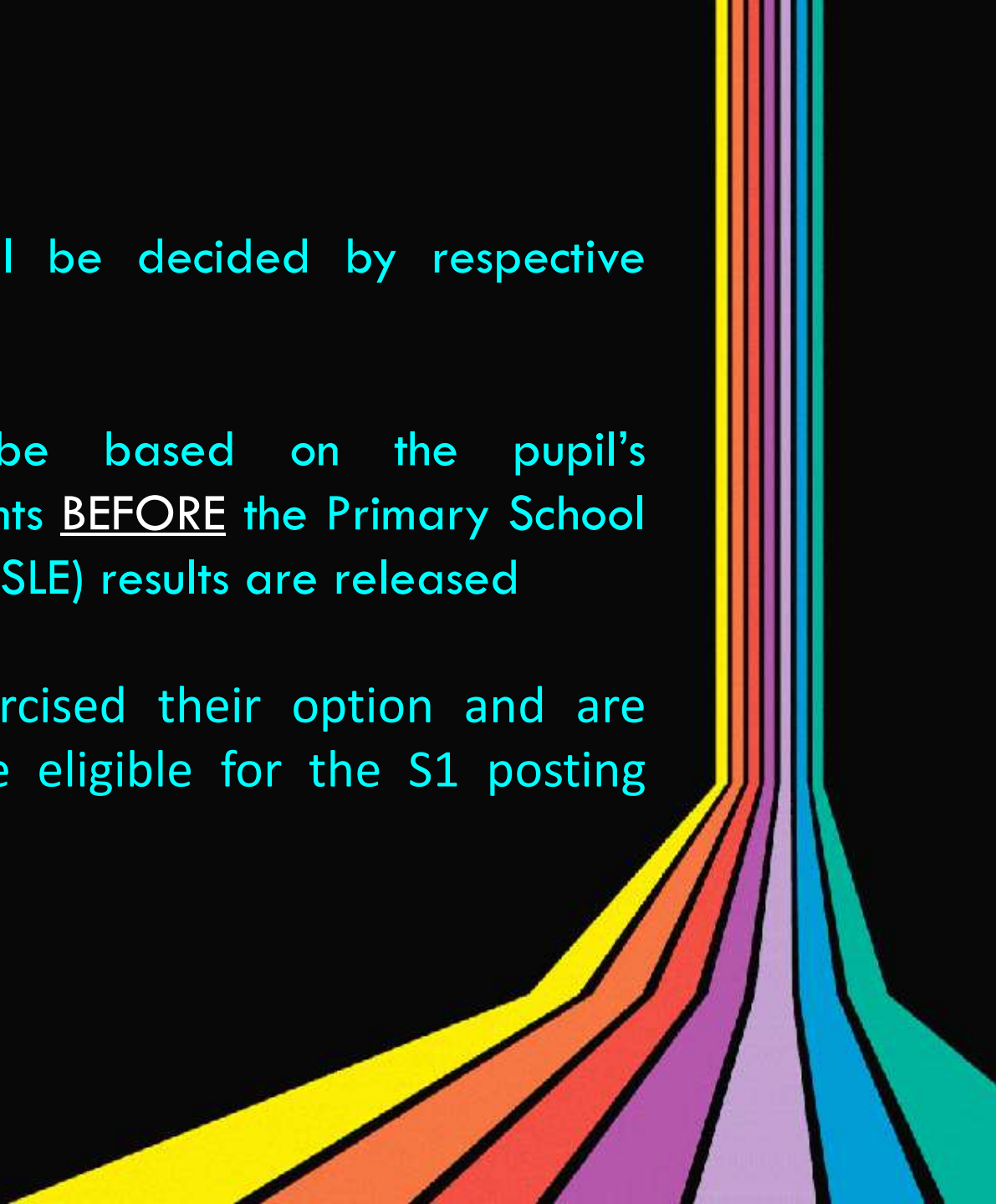
starting from 2017

- Schools' selection process will be more closely aligned with the intent of the DSA – to recognise talents and achievements apart from grades
- Schools will refine their selection of pupils to focus more on talents and achievements in *specific* academic subjects, or in non-academic areas
- Schools will focus less on selecting students based on their general academic ability, which will be assessed and recognised through the PSLE



Things to note:

- Admission Criteria will be decided by respective participating schools
- The selection will be based on the pupil's achievements and talents BEFORE the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) results are released
- Pupils who have exercised their option and are successful will not be eligible for the S1 posting exercise



Stages of DSA Exercise

Information Gathering (Mar – May)

- Admission Criteria
- Identification processes

Information from MOE (Apr)

- Receive letter from MOE regarding DSA (Apr)

Application for DSA Opens (Apr-May)

- Differs for different Sec. Schools

Stages of DSA Exercise

Selection Stage (July – Aug)

- Short-listing & Identification of Pupils for interviews, trials etc

Exercise School Preference (Oct)

- Pupils will be informed if they are rejected, offered or placed on waiting list
- Pupils will exercise their choice online

Results Release (Nov)

- Pupils who are successful will be informed in a letter together with their PSLE results slips
- Pupils who are unsuccessful will join the S1 posting exercise

ADMISSION TO YEAR 1

NUS High School admits 100% of students through the Direct School Admission Secondary (DSA-Sec) Exercise and does not participate in the Secondary 1 (S1) Posting Exercise. If there are vacancies after the DSA-Sec Exercise, a Supplementary Intake Exercise (SIE) may be carried out in November before the end of the S1 Option Phase (selection of secondary schools after the release of PSLE results).

A. DSA-SEC EXERCISE

For admission to Year 1 at NUS High School, local applicants must be currently in Primary Six and sitting for the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) in 2017. Overseas applicants must have obtained an equivalent qualification in 2017. In addition, applicants must be born between the years 2003 and 2005 and not be older than 15 years of age as of 1 January 2018.

The DSA-Sec exercise comprises a Selection Test, Selection Camp and Selection Interview. All applicants will have to sit for the Selection Test. Only shortlisted applicants will attend the Selection Camp, after which selected applicants will be invited to attend the Selection interview. Applicants will be notified of the admission
